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Installing rails for H600S series storage nodes

You must install the slide rails that were shipped to you before you install the H600S series storage nodes.

Before you begin

- You have received the box containing the rails and screws.
- You have a screwdriver.
- You have sufficient personnel to install the nodes into the rack.

About this task


Each rail kit includes a pair of slide rails and screws. The left rail is labeled L and the right rail is labeled R. Each rail consists of an outer, mid, and inner part. As part of the installation, you slide the inner rail out, and attach it to the side of the node. After you install the rails in the rack, you can install the nodes.

Consider the following best practices when you install the nodes in the rack:


- Ensure that you have installed the rack according to the safety instructions from the manufacturer.
- Ensure that the rack is stabilized.
 The heaviest equipment should be at the bottom of the rack.
- Follow proper grounding practices to avoid the risk of electric shock.
- Follow proper airflow and cooling requirements to prevent the hardware from overheating.

1. Before installing the node, install the rails as shown in the following illustrations:
